Month by Month Prayer Tool Option:

Choose one person each month for a year.

50/50 Option: Alternate every other month choosing someone inside church, then outside.

Prayer Tool "lite" - levels if these are too challenging:

Regular - 12 persons "Lite-er" - 2 Persons

"Lite" - 4 persons "Lite-est" - 1 person

HUNTER-GATHERER: Let's go outside and see what we can find that's ripe.

FARMER: Let's create an environment where food can happen. Let's take care of the soil, sow the seed, weed and feed, then reap and repeat.

1. Anyone you speak to once a week.

2. Anyone within 30 feet of you.

3. Anyone on your street.

The Magic Words:

Allow your neighbor to set the agenda for the conversation; be honest about your life - let your conversation be authentic and open; **it's not necessary to hide how you practice your faith.**
